What is the Golden Eagle Marching Band?

TVHS “Pride of the Valley” Golden Eagle Marching Band is the premier ensemble at TVHS. The band is an all volunteer group that performs at all TVHS Home football games, area parades and events, in addition to competing in the Colorado Bandmasters Association Marching Band Contests.

Who can Join?

Any student enrolled in the TVHS Concert Band or Symphonic Band is eligible to join. Color Guard members do not need to be in a ensemble. No previous playing experiences in necessary, but instructor approval is required. Due to instrumentation needs some students may be asked to play secondary instrument.

What is the Time Commitment?

The band begins its season with a band camp and the end of July into August. This camp is mandatory for all participating students. During the year the band rehearses three days a week after school in addition to home football games ,and marching band contest (typically on Saturdays). All rehearsals and performances are required to participate.

How Music Does it Cost?

Each student is asked to pay a \$95 Dollar registration fee and meet a yearly fundraising Goal of \$300. This money can be paid directly by students through personal payments, or through fundraising efforts. This money helps the band pay for travel, food, instructors, music, uniforms, instruments, color guard equipment, and all other cost associated with the marching band.
